Membership Update

We had 49 memberships (27 individuals and 22 family memberships) representing 78 people as of Memorial Day. Three new members joined at the June 9-10 trial bringing us up to 52 memberships; and 81 people.

First Annual Sierra Cup Challenge

The Sierra Cup has 20 competitors that signed up for the Challenge this year. The Sierra Cup Challenge is produced in partnership with mdt-Agility Ability. Both Ready 2 Run and mdt-AA will be looking at the structure of the competition and recommending some changes for 2008 that would accommodate Skilled participants. This year's Challenge was structured after the very successful Paul Kirk Silver Belt Buckle competition, with the rules exactly the same. The Pepper Memorial Classic was part of that competition, so had to comply with the existing rules.

Awards Party Update

The 2007 Awards Party will be on Saturday, August 18th at the Peppermill in Reno. The theme is going to be "Hollywood – Red Carpet", so dressing up is encouraged. Invitations will be sent out the first week in July. The cost for working members is \$10; and non-working members or guests will be \$40. Marie Tobyanson, the Awards Party Chair, is looking for volunteers to assist in the decorating. Patty Diehl and Maudeen Martin are coordinating the awards.

Financial Update

The treasurer reported that we are on target to meet our budget this year, which expects to end the year in the black with about a \$1,000 net profit.

2008 Trial Schedule

The concept of a 4th trial in 2008 was presented to the club. Jeff and Maureen Lyons have been working to expand agility, in particular NADAC, in the Santa Rosa area. They worked closely with NADAC to bring the Fun-Raiser there this year, which was very well received, with lots of R2R members entered. Jeff and Maureen have started AARF (Agility Acres Recreation Field) on their property, will be having Lin Battaglia there in the next few months for a seminar, and have NADAC approved equipment. In order to encourage agility and NADAC in a new and growing

area, the concepts of a 4th trial at the Santa Rosa Fairgrounds was presented to the club. Jeff and Maureen will donate their equipment, to offset the higher costs anticipated to rent the fairgrounds. The club voted and approved the idea to move forward with this trial, April 5-6, 2008.

Additional 2008 dates, at Fuji Park, are May 3-4, June 14-15, and October 18-19.
