Judge's Briefing:

Thank you for inviting me.

- 1) Be sure your leash is on coming in and on again going out.
- 2) Be sure to wait for the "Good Luck" from the judge before taking your leash off.
- 3) Be sure to be on time at the start line. If you are not sure when to go in, the gate steward will tell you when to go in. Please be ready when your turn is near.
- 4) Training in the ring...you get 60 seconds to train from the moment your time starts. Please indicate to the judge if you bring a toy in the ring before you start your run. If you hear a "Thank you" from me, it means your time is up and you need to leave as quickly as possible.
- 5) Leash runners...be sure to present an open leash to exhibitors and do not attempt to leash up the dog, unless you are the leash buddy for that person.
- 6) Also, thank you to everyone volunteering today.
